



- IBSSA International Conference on “Safety of children and families” organised together with Mission Europa and CIP-UIOF between 14 – 16 September 2006 in Budapest / HUNGARY
  - 5<sup>th</sup> "SEC-tember" International Special Security Training Course in Hungary between 19 – 23 September 2006
  - IBSSA Bodyguard World Championships between 26 – 29 October 2006 in Sopron / HUNGARY
  - 12<sup>th</sup> Congress of IBSSA (in 2007 – Belgrade / SERBIA runs for the organisation of the event)
  - 13<sup>th</sup> Congress of IBSSA (in 2008 – planned in ITALY)
  - 14<sup>th</sup> Congress of IBSSA (in 2009 – planned in Arad / ROMANIA)
- Though the next IBSSA Congress is planned to be in Serbia – due to the inconvenient and unclear situation in the country – Mr. Bogdan VUKOSAVLJEVIC, International Coordinator of IBSSA for FYR proposed to organise the 12<sup>th</sup> Congress in Slovenia. The Board of Directors decided to wait for the exact answer from several Serbian groups, and also after checking all conditions they will make the final decision about the host country during the 5<sup>th</sup> “SEC-tember”.
  - The Congress delegates unanimously adopted the proposal that Country Representatives and Chairmen of the departments are strongly recommended to be present or be represented during the IBSSA Congress and Annual meetings!
  - It was also accepted that every year IBSSA will organise an Annual Convention (annual meeting) – which can be organised parallel in the different continents – and every 5<sup>th</sup> year an Elective Congress will be held!

Dr. Rony KLUGER – General Secretary of IBSSA gave a short report on the activities of the newly established Psychology Department of IBSSA and also about the program of the 5<sup>th</sup> SEC-tember International Special Security Training Course. He emphasized the importance of the main subject during the 5<sup>th</sup> SEC-tember, which will be the car-related studies (i.e. combat driving, escorting with car, shooting from the car, self-defence, first aid, etc.).

Prof. George POPPER – President of IBSSA reported about the fruitful cooperation with several international organisations, federations, Knight Orders, and among others with the “Sovereign Order of Cyprus” – which is a military order, a so called bodyguard order, which is in charge with the security of Royal families. The President of IBSSA, who is Grand Collar and Executive Grand Chancellor of the “Sovereign Order of Cyprus” – “Knights of Sword and Silence” used this opportunity to thank to Dr. Rony KLUGER and Dr. Eric Van de WALL their active work and support and inaugurated them to Knight of the “Sovereign Order of Cyprus”.

Previous to the Award Ceremony Dr. András CZAPÁRY (HUN) – Chairman of Technical Department of IBSSA and General Manager of Microrab Electronics Ltd. Co. reported briefly on the activities and new projects of the department.
